


Language

Language examines the standard rules of English grammar, the conventions of the English language, and vocabulary acquisition. Resources can be used to explore grammar topics such as collective nouns, dangling modifiers, and the agreement of nouns and verbs. The Martha Speaks series will build a student's vocabulary and the Global Oneness Project opens a discussion on the importance of language in culture as it investigates dying languages. Figurative language, punctuation, and academic and domain words are additional topics covered.
